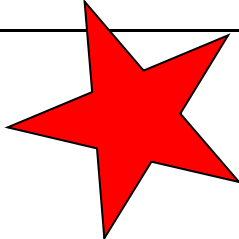

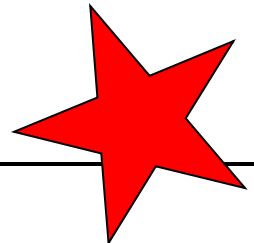

**GORDON V. CORMACK**

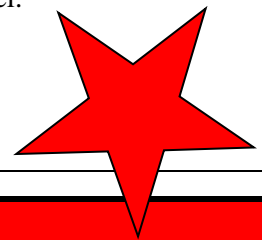
