FORMAT: **NEW FORMAT: 3-Person Team Scramble**
3-Person team scramble play. Minimum of 3 drives per person and 2-putt maximum. Closest to the pin and long drive contests throughout the course.

HANDICAPS: Verified current handicap index of each golfer will be used to determine a team handicap. Each golfer with a verified handicap must use their lowest verified handicap index. A copy of a current handicap index card must be attached to the application. A maximum handicap system will be used by the golf committee for golfers without a verified handicap or for those who did not submit their handicap card. The tournament committee reserves the right to reject or adjust a handicap.

ELEGIBILITY: "Law related golfers" include attorneys and judges, court commissioners and masters, judiciary and law office employees, members of the Armed Forces, Korean Golf Club, Club 40, and law enforcement. Priority will generally be given to attorneys, judges, and said members of the armed forces. THE LAW DAY GOLF COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO DETERMINE ELIGIBILITY AND AVAILABILITY FOR PLAY.

DEADLINE: Wednesday, April 11, 2018. Space is limited to 144 golfers. The Tournament is on a first come, first served basis. Apply early - sell out expected.
