Follow up discussion helps students learn the importance of making good decisions. Presentations run approximately one hour. We are now scheduling presentations for the week of **October 20-24, 2014**, between the hours of 11am—1pm. However, if another date or time is more convenient for you, we will do our best to accommodate you.
