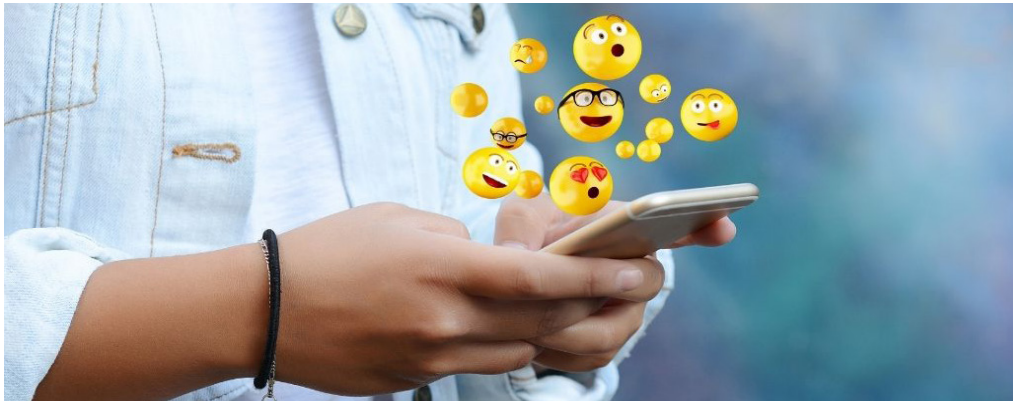

Law of the Emojis
