



## Lawyers' Fund, the Next Best Alternative

Where a client suffers a loss caused by his/her lawyer's dishonest conduct, that client can file a claim with the Lawyers Fund for Client Protection (LFCP). In this seminar, the Chairperson of the Lawyers Fund for Client Protection (Mike Miyahira) and the Lawyers Fund Administrator (ODC's Chief Disciplinary Counsel) will review the requirements and procedures for LFCP claims allowance, and the impact on the profession as a whole. Claims against Dead, Disabled or Disbarred (Triple-D) lawyers are all candidates for LFCP awards, so if you anticipate that any of your colleagues may at some time die, become disabled or disbarred, you might find it useful to learn of this process so you can better advise your colleagues and/or their injured clients.

"Dishonest Conduct" means: "wrongful acts committed by an attorney in the manner of defalcation or embezzlement of money; or the wrongful taking or conversion of money, property or other things of value; or refusal to refund unearned fees received in advance where the attorney performed no services or such an insignificant portion of the services that the refusal constitutes a wrongful taking or conversion of money; or borrowing money from a client without intention or reasonable ability or reasonably anticipated ability to repay it." RSCH Rule 10.1(a).
