## Current Issues in Parliamentary Procedure for Homeowner Associations and Other Organizations That Use *Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised*

By statute, all condominium associations and planned community associations in Hawai'i conduct their association membership and board meetings in accordance with the recent edition of Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised. Many other membership organizations, such as credit unions, also use Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised to conduct their membership and board meetings. Thus, attorneys may encounter issues that require researching Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised. Since 1983, Steve Glanstein, Professional Registered Parliamentarian, has served professionally as a Parliamentarian and sometimes also as a Professional Presiding Officer at more than 1,800 meetings. To prepare for his professional role at any meeting, Steve reads hundreds of pages of association bylaws and other governance documents that are usually written by attorneys. He also issues about twenty-five or so written or verbal opinions each year on parliamentary procedure issues. In this program, Steve will discuss parliamentary procedure issues that intersect with legal issues, such as voting rights. Topics will include issues he has recently encountered at condominium association meetings, direct and indirect voting in community associations, parliamentary procedure considerations for writing or amending bylaws, and top tips for handling difficult meetings. Time permitting, he will also answer your questions on everything you always wanted to know about Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised, but were never given the chance to ask!
