Founded in 2012, the Hawaii State Bar Foundation is an Internal Revenue Code §501(c)(3) non-profit corporation whose purpose is to support the charitable and educational mission of the Hawaii State Bar Association (“HSBA”).

The Foundation was formed as a non-profit vehicle to facilitate fund-raising for projects furthering HSBA’s mission to *promote justice and improve the legal profession*. The HSBA, a §501(c)(6) membership organization, is the sole member of the Foundation with voting rights on essential matters relating to the Foundation.

The Foundation’s **MISSION is to provide charitable and philanthropic support** in furtherance of the HSBA’s mission by:

- Increasing public understanding of the law
- Improving the justice system
- Facilitating delivery of and access to legal services
- Promoting the highest ideals of the legal profession
- Inspiring the philanthropic spirit in Hawaii’s legal community

The HSBA has been raising funds for public service through its annual Bar Dinner since 1993. Proceeds have supported many law-related service organizations and HSBA’s public service projects.

Recent dinner proceeds helped fund in:

- **2011** - the Judiciary History Center’s civics education endeavors;
- **2012** - the courts’ Self Help Centers;
- **2013** - the Judiciary’s Courts in the Community Project, which has brought Hawai`i Supreme Court arguments to public high schools across the State and the 9 ILAF (Indigent Legal Assistance Fund) providers:

Domestic Violence Action Center; HawaiiAppleseed Center for Law and Economic Justice; Hawaii Disability Rights Center; Legal Aid Society of Hawaii; Mediation Center of the Pacific; Native Hawaiian Legal Corporation; University of Hawaii Elder Program ; Volunteer Legal Services Hawaii; American Civil Liberties Union

- **2014** - Bar Dinner proceeds helped support the HSBA’s 2015 public service projects, including civics education, Law Week activities, Leadership Institute, the Junior Judges and mock trials in schools.
- A portion of **2014** Dinner proceeds and Founding Fellow donations will be disbursed in 2015 as grants to projects promoting civics education and access to justice.

The Fellows Program is an integral part of sustaining the Foundation’s mission. The Foundation serves as a vehicle for the legal community to make a difference in Hawai`i by helping make justice accessible to all.
