2. All participants agree to display proper courtroom decorum and good sportsmanship during all aspects of the competition.
3. All participants acknowledge that the reality of the adversarial system is that one party wins and the other loses. The students, teachers and attorney advisors agree to accept either outcome in a mature manner.
4. All participants agree that the highest value should be placed on excellence in preparation, presentation, and sportsmanship.
5. All teachers and attorney advisors agree to refrain from communicating in any form with students during each round.
