Re: 2023 Hawai'i High School Mock Trial Competition – Registration

Dear Administrators and Interested Coaches:

The Young Lawyers Division of the Hawaii State Bar Association is pleased to announce the planning and preparation for the 2023 Hawai'i High School Mock Trial Competition.

This year's Competition will be conducted in a hybrid format to allow for increased participation by teams and volunteers statewide. While the YLD has observed positive trends in returning to in-person events, we have also observed increased participation and interest in the Competition across the State due to the virtual format of the Competition over the past couple of years. Additional information on scheduling and determining whether matches will be held inperson or virtually will be dependent on the teams that register for the Competition. We ask for your patience as our Mock Trial Committee works to deliver the best experience for our students, and thank you for your understanding as we navigate these many changes. Our targeted start date for the ACTUAL competition is in mid-February of 2023.

The 2023 Mock Trial Competition will involve a **criminal** case. The case materials, along with the Competition rules and other related documents, will be posted on the HSBA's website (hsba.org/mocktrial2023) by November 21, 2022. We know that you and your students will put on amazing performances, and gain disciplined organization skills and improve their confidence in their oratory talents.

All Hawai'i high schools are invited to participate. If your school is interested in organizing a Mock Trial team, please submit a completed application form (attached), along with the non-refundable \$250 entry fee, by Friday, December 2, 2022. Teams must have at least seven (7) student participants and a coach.

If your school would like assistance securing an attorney coach, please contact us.

The 2023 Hawai'i High School Mock Trial State Champion team will advance to the National Mock Trial Championship. Please be advised that the 2023 National Championship is scheduled for May 18 to 20, 2023 in Little Rock, Arkansas.
